

# **Academic Achievement 2016**

We set high academic expectations and targets and we are proud of the achievements of the children. These have been consistently high for many years.

In the academic year 2015-16 the government made significant changes to the primary school assessment requirements including higher expectations for pupils to reach by the end of Years 2 and 6. For this reasons there are no direct comparisons with previous academic years. Results for the last academic year for end of both Key Stage 1 and 2 are given below. For the tests pupils were given a scaled score with a nationally expected score of 100 to signify that pupils have met the required standard for the end of Key Stage 2.

56% pupils at Danbury Park Community Primary School reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics compared with 53% nationally and 8% achieved a high level of attainment in all three subjects.
