Happy New Year to you all!

During this term our topic is titled 'Home and Away' and we will be learning about contrasting localities like the Arctic and Antarctic and Deserts and how they compare to our locality. I would also like to encourage all children to read to someone at home every night for about 10 minutes as this is invaluable to your child's learning. If you could initial their home-school link book or write a comment to show your child's reading this will help us to praise your child in school. Can I also remind you that their book bag and PE kit needs to be in school every day.
