
School Photos 7th October


We are sorry but this year we are unable to offer parents the opportunity to include pre-school children in any photos.

Our School Lottery



For every £1 spent by our supporters, the school receives 40p with the rest of the money going towards the prize fund and administration cost. We hope you will agree that for an investment of as little as £1, our supporters have a chance of winning, whilst the school wins every time.

The money raised from the lottery is used by the school to fund projects, activities and to buy resources that we wouldn't be able to do otherwise. There are regular updates in the newsletter on exactly how the support is growing and how much money we have raised and what it has been spent on.

Anyone can take part but supporters must be 16 years of age or older and we do ask that you gamble responsibly.

Safeguarding

Each term we start our Computing lessons with sessions about online safety. These cover the three core aspects:

Content – Is what you are looking at and sharing appropriate?

- Contact Do you know who you are speaking to and interacting with and is this appropriate?
- Conduct Are you behaving appropriately?

This is adapted to suit the age of the children and is made relevant to what they will be using online. In Year 3 as the children move into the juniors, we ask them to sign our *Acceptable Use Agreement*. More information will come from the teachers shortly.

We ask that parents reinforce this and also use it as an opportunity to review practices at home. There are lots of resources available including from the 2 Johns who, hopefully, will be visiting us in June 2021:

Please send monies in with your child via the book bags in a named envelope making cheques payable to Essex County Council. **We would encourage parents to pay in advance for meals and if possible for the whole half-term.** You will only pay for those meals that your child has and any credits will be carried forward to the next term. Please remember school dinners cost £2.25 per day from September 2020. Thank you. Please note Key Stage 1 and EYFS are still entitled to Universal Free School Meals.

Parking

This week we have been made aware that a number of parents have taken to parking along Parkdale and then walking through the footpath to the school. Whilst the resident who contacted us has no problem with this, it would seem that there have been a number of incidents whereby drives have been blocked thereby preventing residents from leaving and accessing their properties, a driver speeding down the road (with his children in the car) and an ambulance struggling to get down the road as a parent had parked opposite another car and both blocked the road and pavement too.

This is obviously very frustrating for the residents but also dangerous. Please consider our neighbours and local community and make sure that you park and drive legally and considerately.

We have been made aware of cars blocking access through the car park at the front of the school. There is only limited space in the car park and causing blockage endangers the safety of pedestrians. If cars cannot flow through the car park, it creates congestion on Well Lane and then onto Main Road. In the past this has then compromised the safety of pedestrians using the zebra crossing. This is dangerous for our families walking to and from school and also members of our community.

There is a disabled bay at the bottom of the car park near the Danbury Outdoors barrier. This should only be used by Disabled Badge holders. When queuing for classes A, B and C please leave this area clear and be considerate to those who need to use this bay.

Please do not park where there are "no parking" signs and do not cause an obstruction whereby other vehicles cannot move thought the car park. This endangers everyone's safety!

There is no excuse for bad driving and parking!
