Weekly Update

.....

Despite the wet and windy weather this week, we have tried to make the most of getting outside to enjoy the fresh air. The tomato plants in Class Hummingbird are coming along well and the children in Class Goldfinch have seen their potatoes starting to sprout and take hold. The seeds that the Early Years children planted are also coming through so we are looking forward to a great crop of vegetables this year.







Mr Carmichael, our relief caretaker, has started work in our school garden and he is planning on creating some additional flower beds to attract the bees and insects. If you are clearing your garden and have any suitable unwanted shrubs that you could donate, we would be very grateful.

We are sharing an important message from Chelmsford City Council Public Health Dept regarding the new Covid-19 Indian variant. A small number of cases of this variant, thought to have originated in India, has been detected in Chelmsford. By regularly taking Lateral Flow Tests from home, households will help take precautionary measures to nip any further spread of the virus in the bud. Because most of the known cases have no obvious link to foreign travel, it is likely that the variant is being transmitted in the Chelmsford community.

We have been advised that this is not a cause for undue alarm, but we do still need to be cautious and help to contain the variant. Chelmsford is being asked to take precautionary Covid tests. Everyone who lives in, works in or visits the Chelmsford district is advised by public health officials to do a <u>Lateral Flow Test</u> as soon as possible. Anyone who tests positive will need to self-isolate and <u>take a PCR test</u>. If the PCR test is negative, there is no need to continue self-isolating. This will prevent the Covid variant from spreading further and help our health service to keep it under control.

Residents can collect at-home test kits from their <u>local library</u>, <u>pharmacy</u> or <u>order online</u>. The self-testing kits are easy to use and deliver results in approximately half an hour. Lateral Flow Test kits ordered from the <u>government website</u> are free and arrive very quickly, often within a couple of days.

Safeguarding

The 2 Johns have now confirmed that they will definitely be going ahead with their planned workshops on Wednesday 9th June although these will be held remotely. All children, except those in Early Years, will take part in the sessions under the guidance of their class teachers as part of our Computing curriculum. The sessions are tailored to each age group and deal sensitively with the potential dangers and how the children can start to take increasing responsibility for keeping themselves safe.

The parent workshops will look at the online world and how our young people are using it and how they are navigating around restrictions and using the internet often without parents' knowledge. All the sessions are up to date and as such, often change on a monthly basis, if not sooner, to reflect the changing risks faced by children and parents in 2021 both pre and post COVID and take into consideration the increased online activity by our young people and how they have adapted to the online world.

This is something that in the experience of the 2 Johns, many parents are still struggling with. This also includes the children's favourite apps and games. They will look at the dangers the children face not only from predatory people but also how they are being groomed in games. They will explore how all our young people are being influenced online and forming ideologies and views that might be diametric to their parents', which can also give them a skewed view of the world, as well as how influencers work, which can lead our children to conduct dangerous challenges.

The good news is that there will be suggestions for solutions that parents can adopt to help keep their children safe which range from settings on apps to safe use of games and how parents should approach the online arena. The 2 Johns will take the Stranger Danger message that parents are familiar with and make it relevant for 2021.

Next week all parents will receive an invitation and link to join the parent session which will start at 8.00pm after most children are in bed! We hope you will take full advantage of this opportunity funded by the DPSA.

Let's work together to keep the children safe!

Brown Tailed Moth Caterpillars





Please note the change of payee as we now have our own bank account and no longer come under the ECC umbrella. This change also means that meals should be paid for in advance and if possible for the whole half-term. You will only pay for those meals that your child has and any credits will be carried forward to the next term. Please note Key Stage 1 and EYFS are entitled to Universal Free School Meals.
