#### Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Repair

This week our new plastic recyling bins arrived and we have set up our recycling stations throughout the school. The children in Class Cuckoo created some great posters and they will all be used as part of our project. However, Charlotte, Emily, Hema and Myah created some particularly eye-catching posters and these were chosen to designate the areas. The girls helped put the bins and posters in place.





We will start collecting clean plastic in school and once a fortnight the children in Class Cucoko will analyse what plastics we are collecting so that we can advise the rest of the school on what could be reduced, reused, recycled or repaired. We have a new display in the front corridor and the children will record our findings so that we can track over time the impact of our actions. They will also share their updates through the newsletter.

The crisp packet recycling bin at the front entrance is clearly labelled and we hope that you will take the opportunity to play your part. Please do NOT wash the packets or fold them as this makes recycling easier. We also have a smaller bin in the hall so that those children who have a packed lunch can also recycle their crisp packets. At the moment the children still need to take home the rest of the debris from their packed lunches as these plastics need to be washed and recycled at home. You might also like to track what they are eating!

Mrs Hind has started using her new fruit bowl so that we no longer use the throw away individual plastic ones and we have a stock of dishwasher proof cups for water for those occasions when children have forgotten their water bottles. Well done to Class Cuckoo for all their efforts in making this project a reality.





#### **Governor News**


Following our full governing body meeting on 29<sup>th</sup> April, we are pleased to welcome Mrs Charlotte Halls as our new parent governor. Mrs Halls has two children at Danbury Park School and is keen to play an active part in our community and in shaping the future direction of the school. 

#### **Notification and Reminders**

Free School Meals – Due to Covid-19 we understand that your circumstances may have changed or may change in the near future and you may now be eligible for free school meals. To check eligibility please contact Essex County Council on 0345 603 2200 or for more information and online application go to https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals

Ink Pens – If your child has their pen licence, could you please make sure that they have their ink pen and cartridges in school. We hold a stock of the small cartridges but these do not fit Parker or Lamy pens. Ink pens are available from the school office at a cost of £1.50.

This change also means that meals should be paid for in advance and if possible for the whole half-term. You will only pay for those meals that your child has and any credits will be carried forward to the next term. Thank you. Please note Key Stage 1 and EYFS are entitled to Universal Free School Meals.


