Weekly Update

This week all our new pupils have started and they have settled amazingly well. *Tapestry*, our online learning journey is a great way for parents to feel part of what is happening in school and the teachers will be busy uploading photos over the coming term. They are also organising a meeting for parents of children in Early Years to learn about phonics and how we teach reading in school, as well as special *Stay and Play* sessions where parents join their children in class to find out about our learning and have some fun by joining in.

We are starting to put together dates and events for this term and at the end of the newsletter is a list. We hope that this helps you plan ahead. Where possible we have given times but some of these will be confirmed once we have finalised the details. Of course these are COVID dependent but we wanted to be optimistic and look forward to a brighter future. Full details of each event will follow in due course.

During the course of this term we will be returning to some of our special events that parents and children value so much. We have just started key stage assemblies again and the children are learning to be part of a bigger group before we return to whole school assemblies and involve the Early Years children. So far they have behaved beautifully, listening attentively and respectfully. For me it has been wonderful to have the children in person, in front of me and not having to speak to them via zoom. We are pleased to announce that over the coming months each class will be preparing a special assembly to share their learning with parents. We will be keeping these small affairs so that we have adequate space and ventilation in the school hall and dates and invitations will follow shortly.

Today I have met with Mrs Hensman and Mrs Emmerson, who are co-chairs of the DPSA. We have set a date of Wednesday 13th Oct at 7.00pm for the DPSA annual general meeting in the school hall followed by a social event so that new parents can come and join us and get to know everyone. We hope you will join us. We have also put dates in the diary for the traditional events for the entire year, which made us feel quite excited to be getting back to normality.

On Monday after school the DPSA has organised a Bouncy Castle event which is a way of welcoming everyone back not just after the summer break but after the lifting of COVID restrictions. We hope that many of you will be able to join us. I know that many tickets have already been sold but these will also be available at the event. Please note that the children do need to be accompanied by an adult.

This Saturday the DPSA will represent the school at the Little Baddow Festival on the Sports Field from 1.00pm, and we hope families will be able to join them.

Morrisons It's Good to Grow

On Monday 6th September Morrisons are launching 'It's Good to Grow' initiative and Danbury Park School has registered so that we can collect tokens to exchange for gardening equipment. The programme aims to encourage school children to get outdoors and get growing, helping them to understand where their food comes from and how to grow their own fruit and vegetables, in order to make healthier food choices now and in the future. We do have a school garden and we hope this year to get the children back involved with this activity this year.

To take part, customers just need to have a *My Morrisons* account and every time they swipe when they shop they'll collect **Grow Tokens**.

How does this work?

- Between Monday 6th September and Sunday 24th October for every £10 spent in store or online, customers will get 1 Grow Token which they can donate to their chosen school
 - Exclusions apply, including tobacco and fuel sales
- Customers will use their My Morrisons app or card when paying to collect their Grow Tokens
 - Token cannot be retrospectively added to a customers account
- Customers can select the school they'd like to donate their tokens to within their My Morrisons
 account
- From 1st November schools will be able to redeem their Grow Tokens against a wide variety of gardening equipment
- Schools will start receiving their order between the end of January and the end of March.

Following last week's newsletter and information on Morrisons "It's Good to Grow" scheme, Jake's mum shared two pictures of him harvesting some of his crop this year.





She said that Jake is extremely proud of what he has achieved on a small plot and was keen to share these pictures with the school. He has for the first time grown carrots, potatoes, peas, runner beans and pumpkins. Tending the vegetables over the summer was fun but the best bit is the satisfactory reward of picking and eating them. Well done, Jake!

We have also started seeing some good results from our school garden and and Mr Carmichael, who has been tending the plot, gathered tomatoes, potatoes and some squash this week.



Safeguarding

We have been asked to pass on this urgent safeguarding alert from Southend Police:

Our online safety experts have been alerted to an extremely dangerous website and app called 'Monkey', which allows users to have video calls with strangers. The platform markets itself as 'an alternative to *Omegle*, with a *TikTok vibe*'. Our online safety experts reviewed and tested this platform and have found that it contains large amounts of inappropriate, disturbing, and harmful content transmitted via web cameras.

What is Monkey?

- Monkey is an online video chat service that is similar to Omegle or Chat Roulette, with a TikTok style
 interface.
- Users can talk to strangers from all over the world via webcam.
- Once a conversation is finished, or one user wishes to leave the conversation or talk to someone else, they click 'next' and are presented with a new user who could be from anywhere in the world.
- Users are asked to select their gender before meeting people.

Age Rating?

- The **website** states that all users must be over 18, but there is zero age verification. Users only have to tick a box to confirm that they are over 18. **Google Play Age Rating**: Parental Guidance.
- The app is currently **only available** on Android devices.

You will only pay for those meals that your child has and any credits will be carried forward to the next term. Please note Key Stage 1 and EYFS are entitled to Universal Free School Meals.
