Learning in Class Goldfinch Autumn Term 2022

Welcome to Class Goldfinch. I hope you all had a restful summer break. Mrs Rush is our class LSA and is in every morning and on a Thursday afternoon.

The first few days have been spent establishing new routines and settling the children in.

We have discussed what helps us to feel safe, happy and able to learn well at school and we have put our ideas into a Class Code of conduct.

During this term our topic is titled 'Voyage of Discovery' and we will be learning about significant individuals and events from the past, with a particular focus on Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus. The questions we will be looking to answer is, 'Who was Neil Armstrong and why is he famous?' and 'Where did Christopher Columbus want to sail to? The children have recorded their thoughts on this already and we shall be revisiting the questions throughout the topic to see if their opinions have changed! We shall also be looking at how life has changed over different periods of time.

In English, we shall look at stories that are in familiar settings, and stories in a fantasy setting. The poetry we study will also have a theme of rhyme and repetition. Non-fiction writing this term will begin with instructions when the children will have the opportunity to write a set of instructions. Later in the term, we shall look at letter writing, which will involve some invitations and writing letters linked to our study of space.

### Reading

I would also like to encourage all children to read to someone at home, every night for about 10 minutes, as this is invaluable and vital to your child's learning. If you could initial their home-school link book or write a comment to show your child has read this will help us to praise your child in school. Each time you record that your child has read to an adult at home, your child's diary is stamped. If your child reads 3 or more times a week they receive a reading sticker. The stickers are awarded on Fridays. At the end of the term, those children that have received a sticker every week will receive a special reading certificate to acknowledge and celebrate their hard work. On Friday the children will select one of our 'Fantastic Friday' books for them to share with adults at home. I know in previous years how popular these books are and how parents enjoy reading these to/with their child.

For those children in Year Two, it is important to discuss the text with your child when hearing them read. This will help develop their comprehension skills.

The children will be given dedicated time to change their books on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.











This term we are focusing on the correct letter formation. This will enable children in Year Two to begin following our school handwriting scheme set of joined letter patterns.

## Maths

Maths this term will focus on place value, number, addition and subtraction. These foundations will then be embedded throughout the year. The children will develop their understanding of number and explore different ways to represent the numbers that they are working with. An Infant Maths booklet will be shared with you this term so you are able to see ways of recording that your child will be taught and this will then enable you to support them at home too.

## History

Our history learning will focus on the lives of significant people who contributed to international achievements.

## Geography

This will be linked to our History topic and the children will be looking at maps, atlases and globes.

# Science

We shall be investigating materials in Science. The children will learn the names of different materials and their properties and then identify the uses of these materials in everyday objects and the properties that make them suitable. We will also look at how and why materials were chosen for items going into space.

# Design Technology

The children will investigate parts on vehicles including the axles and chassis. They will also use junk modelling materials to design and build a model lunar buggy, which they will then evaluate.

### Art

We will be experimenting with a variety of media: pencils, crayons, pastels, charcoal and chalk. The children enjoy doing this! We will be doing some sketching, silhouettes, looking at colour, shade and tone. We shall study the work of famous artists including Van Gogh's 'Starry Night' painting.

# Computing

We will be looking at how to stay safe online, understanding the dangers and that children should seek help if necessary. From this, we will compose our own set of online safety rules for the class. We will also be looking at how to use the internet safely to research about famous people from the past. Using the information collected the children will learn how to present this information in different ways.

### RE

This term we will be looking at Special People and Special Places. We will be looking at the role people play in the local community, famous people and how we commemorate well-known people. We will incorporate learning about specific celebrations including Harvest, Remembrance Day and Christmas. Additional foci will be Sikhism; naming ceremonies and weddings. We will also be looking at places that are special to us; our school, the town we live in and places we visit for a holiday. We will look at Christianity, the local church and other local places of worship. Additional foci will be Islam. These lessons will take place on Thursday afternoons with Ms Middleton.

# **Relationships**

Families and Friendships - Making friends; feeling lonely and getting help.

**Safe Relationships** - Managing secrets; resisting pressure and getting help; recognising hurtful behaviour. **Respecting ourselves and others** - Recognising things in common and differences; playing and working cooperatively, sharing opinions.

# **Class Routines**

Our PE days are **Mondays and Thursdays**, so children will need to bring their shorts, jogging trousers, PE sweatshirt, a t-shirt and trainers on these days. PE kits should be in a drawstring bag. Please remember earrings must be removed for PE lessons and that long hair needs to be tied back every day please. Children will need their outdoor PE kit for their Thursday lessons. It is helpful if your child has a separate bag inside their PE bag to put their shoes in. Please ensure your child has a spare pair of socks kept in their PE bag and that all PE kit is clearly named.

Can I also remind you that their book bag and PE kit needs to be in school every day.

The children have the opportunity and are encouraged to have a drink of water in class after each playtime. Please check that your child's water bottle is clearly named.

Let's presents will take place on Wednesday afternoons. Your child's allocated dates for this term were given in a separate letter. Any resources can be e-mailed to the Class G e-mail. classg@danburypark.essex.sch.uk

All children will have their spellings tested on Fridays. Spelling books are sent home on Fridays and need to be returned to school on a Monday morning. Common exception words will be tested before the end of each half term but these will not be tested on the same day as the weekly spelling test.

This term, once every three weeks the following tasks/challenges will be set. A Mathletics challenge will be set for your child, this will focus on consolidating and extending your child's current learning. Phonics task/challenge on Bug Club. Maths game - the children will take home a maths game which will reinforce different areas of the maths curriculum. Please look out for details in your child's reading diary. If you are unable to access the internet at home please let me know as soon as possible. Thank you.

The children in Year Two have been given login details so they can access Times Table Rock Stars. These will be set to encourage your child to learn the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times-tables.
