Avocet	Summer 1 This half term we will be looking at popular music and how it influences us, and how music can affect our emotions. We will create a playlist of our favourite songs. We will also be learning about and listening to music by our two Composers of the Month.

	Summer 2 This half term we will finish our recorder module and begin our Composer study, <i>Peter and the Wolf</i> by Prokofiev. We will also study our last Composer of the Month.
